These veterans are, for different reasons, really struggling in life. 79% are dealing with mental health challenges, often alongside a range of complex physical conditions. Many experience additional barriers to employment alongside their health condition such as social isolation, age prejudice, inexperience of civilian working life, substance misuse, homelessness and financial and welfare difficulties.
